Other: Vessel Safety Check 6/25




Be sure to check your email for notices up upcoming events, as well as postings of events at Cedar Creek Sailing Center and on our website. We will send and post updates to events and reminders.




#### Party Season is in full swing!!!

Although Summer is not quite here yet and the weather has been less than perfect these last few weeks, the Windjammers haven't let that put a damper on the good times.


