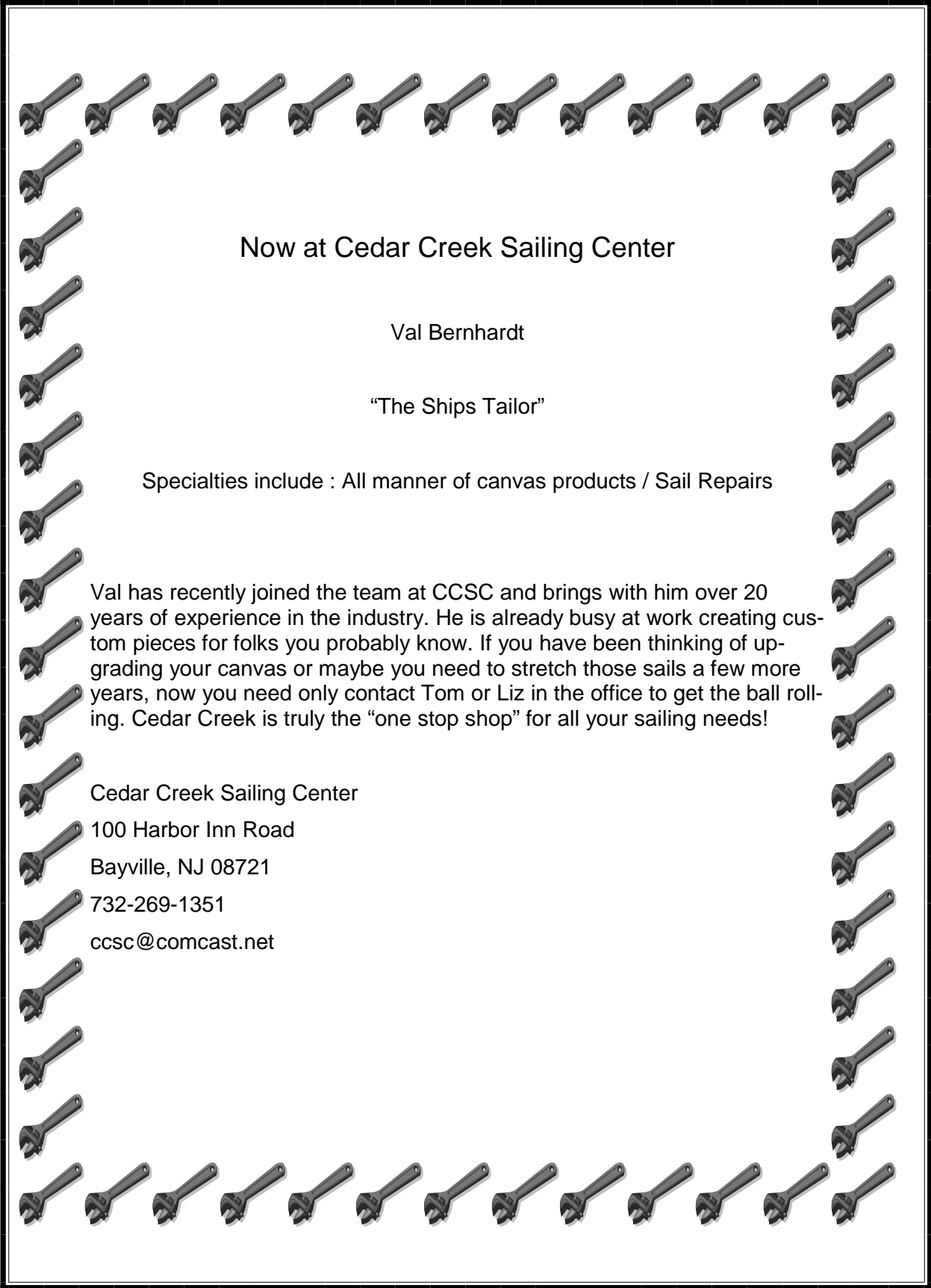

Grilled Mahi Mahi with Pineapple

Ingredients:

|--------------------------------------|------------------------------|
| 3 T. brown sugar | ¼ cup of soy sauce |
| 3 T. minced green onion | 1 T. dark sesame oil |
| 2 t. minced ginger root | 4-4 oz. mahi-mahi fillets |
| 2 t. minced garlic | 8-slices pineapple/ ½" thick |
| ½ t. crushed red pepper | vegetable spray |
| 1 ½ cups unsweetened pineapple juice | |
| fresh spinach leaves | |
| green onion curls | |



Method: Combine sugar, onions, gingerroot, garlic, pepper, pineapple juice, soy sauce, and oil. Place ½ of juice mixture over fillets and pineapple slices. Cover and let marinade in refrigerator for about 2 hours, turning occasionally. Remove fish and slices from marinade, use remaining marinade to baste the food on the grill.

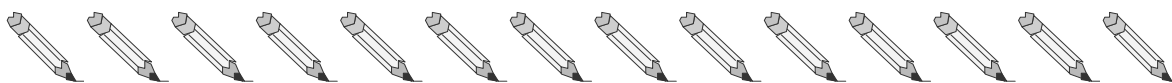
Coat grill with spray, grill fish on medium (about 350 degrees)-about 5-6 minutes each side or until fish flakes easily when tested. Grill pineapple until golden brown. Take the other half of the juice mixture and bring to boil over high heat on the stovetop. Set aside and keep warm.

Arrange fish and pineapple on a platter, drizzle with boiled mixture. Garnish with fresh spinach leaves and green onion curls. Serves 4 (or 2 if you're really hungry!)

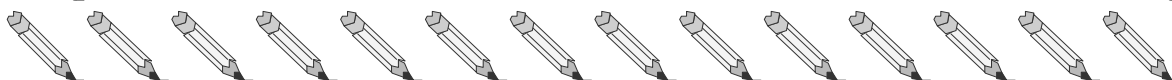
Seminars Update

Following that theme we will be having another video for the racing seminar scheduled for June 6th at 10 AM preceding the practice race followed by the Chicken & Ribs party.

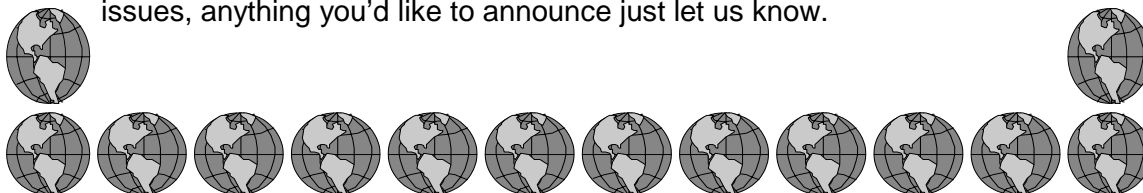
